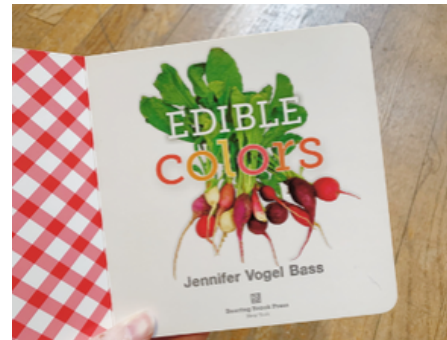

- Approximate time - 5 minutes

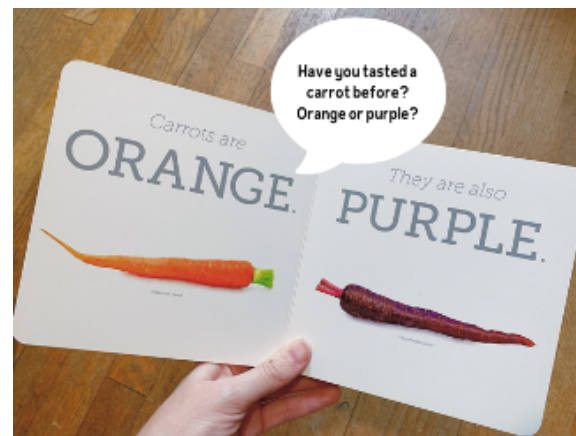
Materials

Review the colors as you read. Connect to children's personal eating experiences by discussing familiar foods as they are shown in the book. Also, note that turnips often have a purple top, when discussing purple fruits and vegetables.
