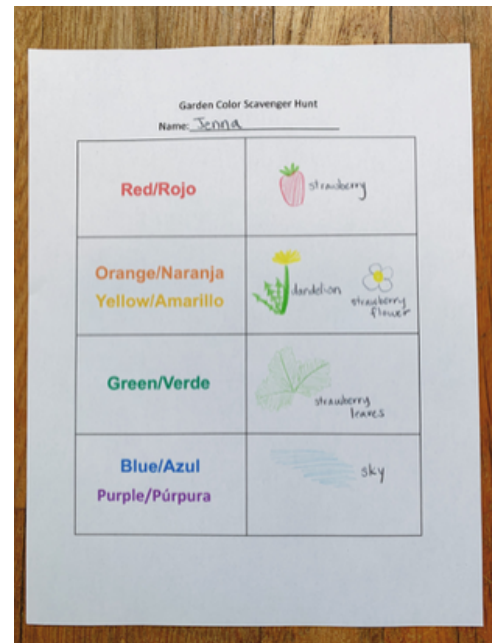
- Group structure - small groups
